The purpose of this assistance under the Fisheries Structural Adjustment Scheme (FSAS) – Stage 3 is to provide a co-contribution grant of up to \$100,000 to pay owners of an eligible business to diversity their business if it relied on fish taken under a primary commercial fishing licence from Great Barrier Reef fisheries on which now retired fishery symbols (N1, N2 or N4) were written or from particular parts of the Great Sandy region.

The amount of assistance available is 50% of the cost of implementing a diversification plan for the applicant's eligible business, up to
