About the scheme				
The Queensland Sheep and Goat Electronic Identification Rebate Scheme is being introduced to strengthen livestock traceability. Sheep and goat mandatory individual electronic identification (eID) improves biosecurity and traceability, including accurate and timely tracing to help reduce the duration and industry impact of an emergency animal disease outbreak or residue incident. The purpose of the Queensland Sheep and Goat Electronic Identification Rebate Scheme (the Scheme) is to encourage uptake and compliance with the introduction of mandatory eID of sheep and goats in Queensland by giving primary producers and livestock agents a rebate to offset up to half the cost of purchasing eligible hardware. Please note, program funding is limited. Completed applications will be assessed in order of submission (i.e. first-in, first-served). <b>Rebates will be available until the Scheme's closing day on 30 June 2025, unless Scheme funding is exhausted prior.</b> Before completing this form you should carefully read the Scheme guidelines available on QRIDA's website <b>qrida.qld.gov.au</b>
